**ORDER**

As part of implementation and monitoring of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in the State, Planning & Economic Affairs (CPMU) Department has been designated as the Nodal Department and its Director as the Nodal Officer as per the Government orders read as 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> above. In order to achieve the Goals and associated Targets by 2030, all stakeholders will have to be represented in the Institutional Framework for implementation and monitoring of SDGs in the State.

2. For each Goal, a Nodal Administrative Department is designated. A State Level Steering Committee (SLSC) has been constituted with Secretaries concerned as members, Secretary, Planning & Economic Affairs as the Convener and Chief Secretary as the Chairperson, vide paper read as 3<sup>rd</sup> above. Each Nodal Administrative Department is having a Nodal Officer to coordinate activities related to the respective Goal with Implementing Departments/Agencies.

3. Task Forces are the entities proposed to support the State Nodal

Officer for attainment of each Goal in the 2030 Agenda. The composition of Task Forces will be as follows:

- i. Nodal Officer from the Nodal Administrative Department
- ii. One official (Not below the rank of Assistant Director or equivalent, conversant in the subject) each from various Implementing Departments/Agencies related to the Goal
- iii. Director, CPMU (Convenor)
- iv. One official from Implementing Departments/Agencies of LSGD
- v. One official from Department of Economics and Statistics

4. General conditions:

- i. Officials in the Task Forces shall be changed as and when transfer/promotion/retirement is taken place with suitable replacement.
- ii. Each Implementing Department/Agency shall nominate officials to the Task Forces as required above.
- iii. Subject experts can be invited if the Task force decides so.
- iii. Nomination of officials shall be done on designation -wise and not on nominal.

5. Roles and responsibilities of Task Forces are the following:

- Each member of the Task Force from departments/agencies shall act as bridge between corresponding Administrative Departments / Implementing Departments / Implementing Agencies and CPMU in matters related to implementation and monitoring of SDGs.
- Task Forces shall give necessary inputs to CPMU for the preparation

of documents in respect of State Level Steering Committee (SLSC),  
SDG Monitoring Group (SMG), and Expert Group meetings.

- Task Forces will be a permanent group till the 2030 agenda is achieved in the State and they are responsible to ensure technical support to the State Nodal Officer (Director, CPMU) in the process of implementation and monitoring of SDGs.
- Nodal Officer from each Nodal Administrative Department shall liaise with the Implementing Departments/Agencies under the corresponding Goal.

6. Hence Government are pleased to constitute Task Force for each Goal as detailed above for the smooth implementation and monitoring of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in the State.


