ORDER

As per GO 1st read above, Government have nominated the Director, Planning & Economic Affairs (CPMU) Department as the Nodal Officer and later revised the order designating Planning & Economic Affairs (CPMU) Department as the Nodal Department and its Director as the Nodal Officer vide GO 3rd above for implementation and monitoring of SDGs in the State. In order to facilitate smooth implementation and monitoring of SDGs in the State, an SDG cell was constituted vide orders 4th & 5th read above at Planning & Economic Affairs (CPMU) Department to support the Nodal Officer under the direct supervision of Assistant Director of the Department comprising of one Research Officer of the Department and Research Associates on contract basis. CPMU was de-linked from Planning & Economic Affairs Department and formed as a new Administrative Department named as Programme Implementation, Evaluation & Monitoring Department vide G.O. read as 6th above.

2. The Joint Director/Senior Joint Director assists the Nodal Officer by closely supervising the activities of the SDG Cell. In the Institutional Framework for implementation and monitoring of SDGs in the State, SDG Cell under the Nodal Department plays a vital role and hence it has to be strengthened by inducting Senior Joint Director into the SDG Cell. The roles and responsibilities of SDG Cell are as follows:

- To extend all technical assistance needed for smooth implementation and monitoring of SDGs in the State.
- To do all coordination and liaison works with the stakeholders and Implementing Departments/Agencies in connection with the activities related to SDGs.
- To document all activities related to SDGs in the State and prepare status reports as and when required.
- The SDG Cell will upkeep and maintain all data/reports/publications related to SDGs.
- To make available Best Practices of other states, analyse and compare with the Best Practices in the State in its stride towards achieving Agenda 2030.

Under the circumstances, Government are pleased to re-constitute the SDG Cell with Joint Director/Senior Joint Director as the head and Assistant Director, Research Officer concerned, Research Associates as members.


